


# Why Giving Matters

As former Chairs of the Advancement Committee and Viewpoint Fund, Olga and I came to understand that tuition only covers about 85% of the cost of a student's education at Viewpoint School. The School absolutely depends on donations from its families to bridge this gap. Annual giving to the Viewpoint Fund makes up 7% of Viewpoint's annual budget. This works out to be an average of \$3,000 per student on top of tuition.

When it came time every year for us to make our Viewpoint Fund contribution, we'd look at each other and say, 'If not us, then who and if not now, then when?' And we never felt better about writing a check!"


